Terms And Conditions (abbreviated English version)

1. Organiser and event team

Organiser on behalf of the MGCC Deutschland e.V. is the event team named in the event information leaflet. Any questions to be directed to he club secretary (sekretaer@mgcc.de)

2. General conditions

All MG branded cars can be registered for the event, which is not a road race but a touristic drive and the German highway code (Strassenverkehrsordnung – StVO) has to be respected by all participants.

In respect to the car's data, "year" means the year of first registration.

Every driver needs to have a valid driving licence. The cars must be roadworthy and registered for the road in their country of origin.

3. Registration for the event

Registrations can only be made in writing, using the completed form on the obverse. On registration the applicable fee is payable to the bank account indicated. Registrations without payment cannot be processed. The maximum number of cars is set by the event team. Registrations will be processed in order of reception by the team.

The deadline for registrations will be set by the event team and published in the event information leaflet. Registrations received at a later date may be rejected without further explanation. The fees paid are not refundable, any services not used by the participants cannot be reimbursed.

4. Environment protection

All participants are subject to the German soil protection law (Bundesbodenschutzgesetz – BBSchG). Any contamination by oil or other liquids is to be removed and correctly disposed by the person responsible.

5. Disclaimer

Participation in the event is on your own risk. The routes described are just a suggestion which need not be followed. The event organiser may exclude cars from the event. The participants waive all claims against the event organiser and the team in whichever relation to the event these claims could be made.

6. Insurance

All necessary insurances required by the government authorities have been concluded by the organiser. With their registration the participants declare that driver, passengers, and the car registered is fully insured for road use. They exempt the organiser and the event team from all liabilities thereof.

7. Participants' obligations

The rally plate with the start number has to be visibly fixed to the car, not blocking the registration plates. The cars will not necessarily be started in their numbered order.

8. Scores and prizes

Scoring will be done in points. A division into groups according to year and type of cars and potential other features is to the sole discretion of the event team. The awards will be determined by the event team. Protest is excluded.

9. Changes to the event

The organiser retains the right to alter the event in parts or completely if necessary.

10. Severability clause

If any of these terms and conditions shall be held invalid, the remainder shall, nevertheless, be deemed valid and effective.

11. Data protection

On registration the participants permits the organiser and the event team to store and process their data as given on the registration form. This includes the consent of parents/guardians in case of the registration of minors.

Data processing is mace in accordance with the German data protection code (Datenschutz-Grundverordnung – DSGVO). This permission can be revoked at any time by e-mail in no specific form to the event team.

The data collected will be deleted after the event is finished, unless certain legal obligations (especially accounting) do not require otherwise.
